


# 1. Clitoral hood

#### **Short-term effects**

Severe pain

Severe loss of blood

Attack of sudden cramps / Shock

**Blood** poisening

Infection with tetanus, HIV, etc.


### Reasons for Female Genital Cutting

#### Reinforcement:

Uncircumcised women are less likely to get married

#### **Reinforcement:**

Threat that ancestors may punish families who refuse to circumcise their girls






